- The scholarship award amount is \$100.00 for senior boys and girls.
- Scholarships will be awarded in the spring of each year before graduation from high school.
- Scholarship checks will be drafted in the name of the University or College the recipients will be attending.
- Scholarships will be awarded to as many qualifying graduates as funds allow.
- Students must have played at least three years in the Hancock Soccer Association program to be eligible for a scholarship.
- Students should complete all sections of the application form.
